Guest chef presenters, live and silent auctions, world-class cuisine, fine wine, cooking schools, and more make this festival a truly special program. ### **Festival History**

The annual Wine & Food Festival is the result of an ad hoc committee formed in 1992 by the MSU Billings Foundation & Alumni. The committee was tasked with exploring options for a special event which would increase campus visibility, provide scholarship dollars to students, and engage community volunteers with the foundation and university. Dona Hagen, Gail Waller, Dottie Hollatz, Corby Skinner, Deb Dzuck and Dr. Bruce Carpenter were the founding committee members. After researching nationwide festivals, the foundation approved the idea for a wine festival and provided the necessary start-up funds. Briggs Distributing Company and Marriott Food Services joined the team to make the first event a success. In 1993, the first Wine & Food Festival took place over two days and raised \$43,000 in net proceeds.
